

Whitman Takes Game One in Playoffs.

It was all about Wildcat pride Tuesday night as a tough Copiague team gave Whitman all they could handle. The first 3 quarters were a constant battle, the back and forth scoring, with Copiague ahead by a couple of points at the end of each of the first 3 periods made for exciting basketball.
